All Scripture points to one thing. Read what Jesus said in John 5:39!

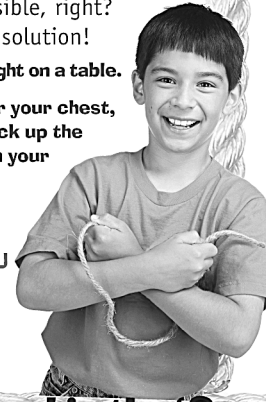
Without God's Word, it's impossible to know how to live a life that pleases him.

IT'S LIKE THIS.

- 1 Hold one end of the rope in each hand, and tie a knot without letting go of the ends.
Seems impossible, right?
But there's a solution!
- 2 Lay the rope out straight on a table.
- 3 Cross your arms over your chest, then lean over and pick up the ends of the rope with your arms still crossed.
- 4 Unfold your arms.

THERE'S THE KNOT YOU WERE TRYING TO TIE!

You'll need a length of rope or clothesline. It should be at least a foot long.

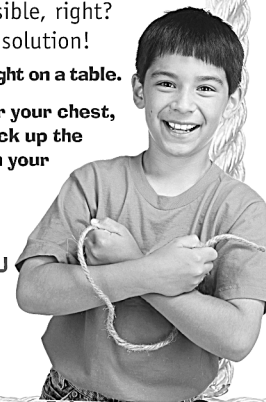

IT'S LIKE THIS.

- 1 Hold one end of the rope in each hand, and tie a knot without letting go of the ends.
Seems impossible, right?
But there's a solution!
- 2 Lay the rope out straight on a table.
- 3 Cross your arms over your chest, then lean over and pick up the ends of the rope with your arms still crossed.
- 4 Unfold your arms.

THERE'S THE KNOT YOU WERE TRYING TO TIE!

You'll need a length of rope or clothesline. It should be at least a foot long.
