Who is Where Moms Connect for?

Where Moms Connect is a faith-based curriculum for moms' ministry groups who want to reach out to **moms of all ages and all stages of momhood.**

Why use Where Moms Connect?

All moms want and need support and connection with other moms. At your Where Moms Connect group, moms will find caring friends who will share in the laughter and joy as well as the frustration and tears that momhood can bring—all within a safe, fun, and encouraging environment that's centered on the Bible.

What happens at a typical Where Moms Connect gathering?

Inside each Where Moms Connect Kit, you'll find everything you need for leading 18 gatherings (most moms' groups meet about twice a month during the typical school year). You'll need someone to facilitate each gathering by using the curriculum found in the Leader Guide. Nine of the sessions for the theme "A Year of Adventure" also include DVD content, which is provided in the kit.

Connecting Together

Each session begins with a time called "Connecting Together." This is when you'll help moms get into small groups and get acquainted in a comfortable way using icebreakers and discussion.



Connecting to My Life

Finally, moms personalize what they've learned and consider how the day's topic applies to their own lives in "Connecting to My Life." This helps them take home what they've learned and use it right away.



Connecting With God

The Where Moms Connect curriculum helps moms take a faith-based approach to momhood. During the "Connecting With God" time of each gathering, you'll bring the Bible and faith into the discussion as it relates to the day's topic.

Connecting to the Topic

Once everyone's had a chance to get to know one another, women move a bit deeper as the Session Leader guides the conversation into "Connecting to the Topic." Moms will learn new things and share their own stories and ideas.



How long is each gathering, and when is a good time of day?

You'll want to allow at least one hour for each gathering. You can add in time for fellowship at the beginning and/or the end of each get-together for as long as you'd like.

The best way to find out what time works for the moms in your ministry is to simply ask other moms! If it seems hard to find that magic time, you may want to consider having more than one gathering time to accommodate the different needs. But don't get discouraged—it's hard to find a time that works for everyone! Aim for the majority, and don't forget the point is to reach as many moms as possible—even those who work!

What's the cost?
